## 6. Charles Hall Museum



Sitting at the crossroads where travelers have passed for 10,000 years, the museum offers a large collection of artifacts from Tellico Plains and the surrounding area. The collection is owned by one man – Charles Hall – and he enjoys sharing the collection and his knowledge of history with visitors.

The Museum sits at the western gateway for the Cherokee Skyway, a magnificent National Scenic Byway that climbs to over 5,000 feet in elevation to link Tellico Plains, TN to Robbinsville, NC. The road runs through two national forests—the Cherokee and the Nantahala—thus the name “Cherokee.”
